

## Broadleaf Weeds



### Ragweeds

Common: Common Ragweed, Giant Ragweed

Scientific: *Ambrosia artemisiifolia*, *Ambrosia trifida*

Affected Crops: Barley, corn, cotton, pasture, soybeans.

#### Identification:

**Common** - This annual broadleaf can grow to 4 feet in height. The stems and leaves are blue-green color and the leaves are deeply lobed with rounded tips. Small hairs cover the underside of the leaf, resulting in a gray appearance.

**Giant** - The purple seedling has large round cotyledons. It also is a tall erect annual with opposite leaves that are lobed and attached to the stem with a long petioles.

#### Geographical

Geographical Distribution: Common throughout the United States. It is often found in waste areas and along ditches.
